“Face & Space” – “Sign to English” – “Where Are We Going With This?”

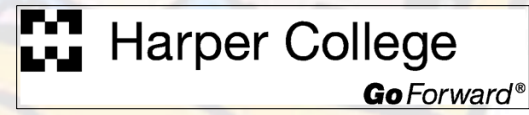
“Where Are We Going With This? Processing/ Conveying Intent in K-12 Settings” - Friday, June 11th * 9a - 4p * 6 hours CEU
The presenter will discuss how teachers use a variety of techniques in the classroom, how interpreters can catch the cues that reflect the teacher’s intent, and how to use ASL features to convey the intent of the teacher. Participants will review video of classroom lectures, practice recognizing and conveying teacher intent, and review model interpretations for each lecture.

“Sign to English Skill Development for the EIPA” - Saturday, June 12th * 9a - 12p * 3 hours CEU
Sign-to-English interpreting poses a challenge to many interpreters. This is especially true when taking assessments like the EIPA, NIC or employment-related skill tests. The presenter will discuss the skill domains rated by the EIPA. Strategies for "voicing" on tests will be shared and modeled. Participants will gain more strategies and confidence for test day!

“Face & Space“ Going Above & Beyond Interpreting in Educational Settings - Saturday, June 12th * 1p - 4p * 3 hours CEU
Test results often show that interpreters have strengths in vocabulary, fingerspelling and numbers. However, the richer skills of prosody and use of space need development. Using you "face and space" allows the student to more easily understand the message, retain the learned information, and then retrieve and utilize what they have learned. The presenter will share techniques for using more "face and space" to enrich your interpretations. The workshop will be conducted in a safe and fun environment!
