January 19, 2008: 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. “Fingerspelling: The Role and Importance of Fingerspelling When Interpreting in the K-12 Setting”

This workshop is designed to help interpreters understand the role and importance of fingerspelling when interpreting for children in K-12 settings.

March 15, 2008: 11:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. “Spatial Organization: Organizing the Signing Field to Enhance Message Equivalence/Effectiveness”

This workshop will focus on the use of signing space to convey verb agreement, locative information, the incorporation of classifiers, use of comparative/contrastive space, real world and model space.
